

Why not design your own bunting for the VE day 75 celebrations on Friday the 8th of May? Victory in Europe (VE) day commemorates the end of war in Europe in 1945. Around the country, many people had street parties to celebrate VE day although war continued in the Far East and wasn't officially over until August.

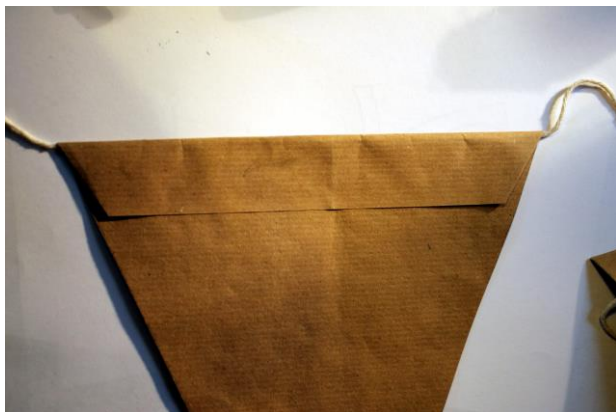
You will need:

- Paper or card
- Scissors
- Felt tip pens, crayons, pencil or paint
- String
- Glue stick

How to make your VE themed bunting:



Measure your paper based on template 1 (top 20cm wide and 24cm from top to tip).



Measure 2cm down from the top and draw a line across. Fold along the line to form a flap. Fold in the corners so they don't stick out.

- Turn over your bunting and draw, colour, paint your 1940's design. Make as many of these individual bunting pieces as you would like.
- Cut a long piece of string and put it under the flap then glue it shut. (see template 2)



Hang your bunting to decorate your house!
