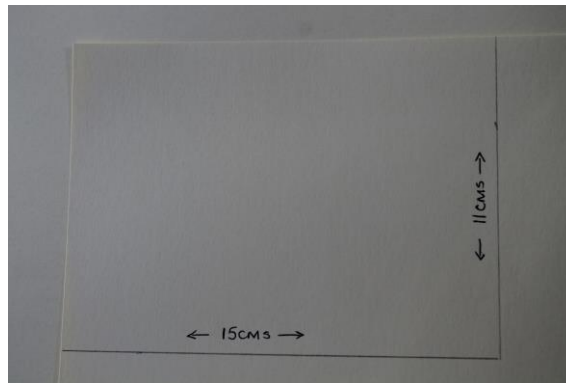


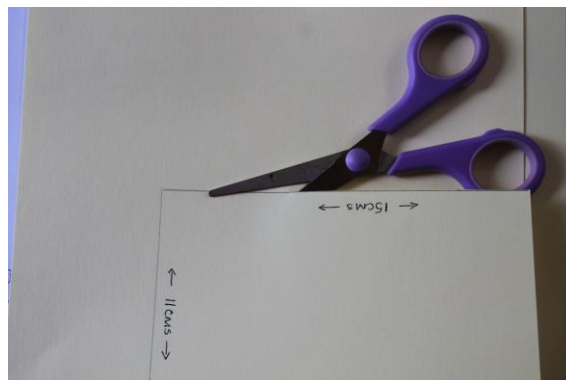
Postcards
